Resource sharing: A term

covering a variety of organisations and activities engaged in jointly by a group of libraries for the purposes of improving services and/or cutting costs. Resource sharing may be established by informal or formal agreement or by contract and may operate locally, regionally, nationally, or internationally. The resources shared may be collections, bibliographic data, personnel, planning activities, etc. Formal organisations for resource sharing may be called bibliographic utilities, cooperative systems, consortia, notworks hibliographia sorvice



## Library consortium: A

formal association of libraries, usually restricted to a geographical area, set number of libraries, type of library, or subject interest, that is established to develop and implement resource sharing among the members and thereby improve the services and resources available to their respective target groups.

#### **MOBIUS** Consortium

MOBIUS is a vibrant, collaborative partnership of libraries providing access to shared information resources, services, and expertise.

Cost-effective shared e-book collections available only to consortium members.

MOBIUS staff provide on-site training, tailored to the needs of each library, on demand and at no extra cost. Library vendors can chance thousands of dollars for such services.


Collaborative opportunities at all levels is provided through discussion lists, committees, task forces, and the annual conference. The consortial environment fills a major skill and capacity gap beyond the reach of individual libraries, as large institutions provide expertise and assistance to smaller ones.

The MOBIUS Annual Conference, which features national keynote speakers, is **free** to all member library staff, providing a venue where library staff can present, share expertise, and gain valuable professional development.



## Liquidity risk

Approximately 79% (2021/22: 78%) of the Library's income is provided by Grant in Aid from the Department for Culture, Media and Sport which is drawn down according to need. The remaining income is self-generated and is volatile. Remote Document Supply is still the major source of self-generated income. As the majority of the Library's cash requirements are met through Grant in Aid, financial instruments have less potential for creating risk than would be the case for a non-public-sector body of similar size.

The Library holds highly liquid assets amounting to £68m at 31 March 2023 (2021/22: £64m) which are comprised of cash at bank and in hand and short term deposits. The Library regularly monitors the deposit portfolio to manage exposure to liquidity risk.





Both onsite and remote enquiries have been significantly below target. The onsite performance reflects the low visits to Reading Rooms during the year. A marketing campaign started in September 2022 to try and improve Reading Room visitor numbers.


Items consulted online, onsite and through remote delivery<sup>1</sup>. Includes physical and electronic items consulted in Reading Rooms, items consulted on the Library website, Collection items consulted on partner websites and items supplied remotely via the Document Supply service.



Items consulted on partner websites have performed well overall although visits to the British Newspaper Archive site were 5% below target. Items consulted in Reading Rooms, on the British Library website and items supplied remotely have all been behind target.

Other organisations that are part of this ecosystem are commercial document supply and delivery vendors generally used to take advantage of their search and sharing technology platforms and/or to gain access to a wider range of harder-to-find content. These suppliers can also provide access to contemporary published content if they have the licence agreements in place, which can be convenient as they will aggregate various publishers into one user interface. They may also be able to offer access more cheaply than publishers can directly, due to bulk discount arrangements. Examples include the British Library (BL on Demand), the SUBITO document delivery service, the Copyright Clearance Centre (Get it Now), and Research Solutions/Reprints Desk (Article Galaxy). [P7]
