Abstract

To understand how Britons viewed the Second World War, *The Sceptic Isle* integrates propaganda history with political, media, and above all military history. Previous works have often examined these different facets in isolation. As this book shows, it was the interaction between what propagandists and politicians hoped to achieve, on the one hand, with how the battlefield unfolded and how it was reported, on the other, that often shaped how the public thought about the war. Because some politicians and many reporters often questioned the official line, the result was a disconnect between government and governed that often threatened to turn into a major credibility gap. Of course, however grim the situation, British morale never collapsed. 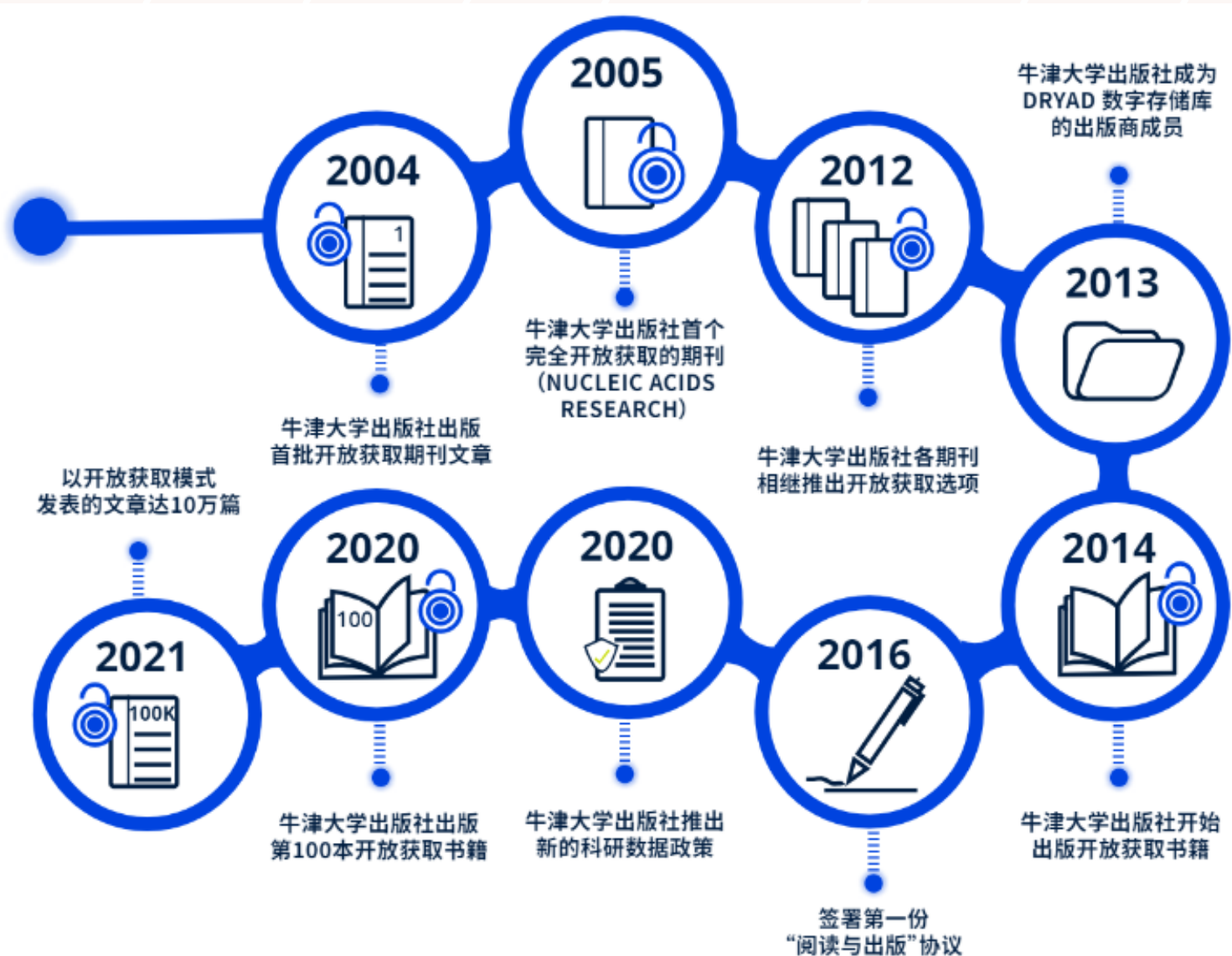
